

Horsemanship Additional Packing List

This list is in addition to the Camp Nakamun Main Site Packing List and is for all Horsemanship Campers.

We are outside around animals and exposed to the elements, riding through forested, brushy areas. Be prepared for any kind of weather, even in the middle of summer. Getting dirty is highly probable and clothing plays a huge role in protecting you from the sun, brush and bugs, so bring clothing appropriate for these conditions.

- Clothing (modest)
- Long pants for riding (jeans or breeches)
- Sweaters (for cool evenings)
- Hat (ball cap or brimmed hat, something to keep the sun off)
- Riding helmet (if you don't have one they are supplied)
- Boots (English or western riding boots are preferred, but rubber boots are acceptable, fashionable high heeled boots/shoe will not work and most often are ruined and fall apart in the ranch environment.
- Socks appropriate for inside boots. (short ankle socks often cause blisters to form)
- Running shoes (Sneakers are a good idea, something to wear while on the ground around the campfire or cabin)
- Rain jacket (must be a coat or jacket, the rain ponchos are not safe around the horses)
- Waterbottle - hydrate, hydrate, hydrate. Very important since we will be outside alot
- Small backpack for hauling swim/shower gear to and from the main site.

Optional Items to Bring:

- Rope (AKA Lariat) - We can teach some basic roping skills.
- Pocket Knife (Horsemanship Camps only)
- Your own saddle. We can not guarantee it will fit our horses but we will try blankets and pads are provided.

Of course all needed ranch equipment and saddles are provided.

Do Not Bring

- Electronics (cell phones, ipods, tablets, ect.)
- Jewellery

- Clothing or items you cherish. They might get lost or dirty.
